Establishing the Need For Out-of-School Time (OST)

Growing research suggests that quality after school programs can positively impact children, with similar benefits extending to school district performance. These programs also play a role in addressing risks associated with the absence of supervision after 3pm.

Unfortunately, many enrichment programs have not kept up with the times and fall short. For example, one of the most common complaints about before and after school programs is that they offer little more than babysitting—missing a critical opportunity to provide meaningful enrichment that yields long-term rewards.

Many of us remember programs like this from our own childhood, and the reality is that many programs have not changed much over the past 20-30 years. Parents often report that such programs lack flexibility or availability, and students say they're "boring" and "no fun."

Enrichment programs today should be able to offer districts and families much more. For example, in addition to supervision, a high-quality program should provide opportunities for academic enrichment and social-emotional growth through a fully developed curriculum.





Right At School's proprietary Disguised Learning™ curriculum infuses extra learning time into the day without causing student burnout.

We know the last thing a child wants to hear at the end of the school day is, "Who wants to learn some more?" That's why we thoughtfully incorporate learning into fun and engaging activities. For example, in the unit Inventor's Workshop, students learn about Roman Aqueducts and apply Design Thinking as they engineer, test, and iterate their own designs built out of recyclables.

We thoughtfully enhance our curriculum every year to address learning goals in our local school district communities. With 180+ hands-on, STEAM-focused activities, students will continue learning key concepts long after the last school bell rings.

The Positive Impact of Physical Activity

According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), experts estimate less than 24% of children between the ages of 6 and 17 in the United States participate in 60 minutes of physical activity per day.

Furthermore, the CDC reports that "in addition to physical education and recess, classroom physical activity provides another opportunity during the school day to promote student physical activity, and it offers its own unique benefits."

Unfortunately, schools do not have time to integrate exercise into classroom time during the school day, positioning out-of-school-time programs as a beneficial place to introduce focused time for physical activities.

Right At School Makes Time to Move & Play

Making time for daily movement and fun fitness activities is an essential part of all Right At School programs — from Before and After School to Summer Camp.

Our educators model positive social interactions and sportsmanship through fun games and sports. We also provide unique equipment and activities to make physical activity fun for all. Children are provided choices, including participating in staff-led games, such as *Steal the Bacon* and *Johnny Come Across*, as well as the opportunity to self-navigate in supervised play on the playground individually or with friends, or to develop a game on their own with peers, such as Flag Football.

Our fitness curriculum offers a wide range of outdoor as well as indoor activities, so even when weather is inclement, we keep everyone moving and fit.

The Benefits Of Personal Growth through Healthy Socialization

Participating in a high-quality out-of-school-time program can provide students with hours of positive socialization and social-emotional development every week. Such programs provide specific, structured opportunities to practice and exemplify the SEL character traits that have been identified and prioritized by school districts. All of this can help promote mental, physical, and emotional well-being, helping kids cope, grow, and flourish.

In fact, research shows that children experience a variety of social-emotional benefits from participating in high-quality extended day programs.

SUCH BENEFITS INCLUDE:*

- Improved behavior for nearly 60% of participants
- Greater social-emotional skills (self-management, decision- making, self-awareness, peer social skills)
- Higher self-concept, confidence, and sense of belonging

SOCIAL-EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT HAS ALWAYS BEEN A CORE COMPETENCY OF RIGHT AT SCHOOL.

Because development is more "caught" than "taught," we infuse our program content, methods, and experiences with opportunities for children to practice personal responsibility, relationship skills, self-awareness, and positive self-identity.

JUNIOR EDUCATOR PROGRAM

Through the Junior Educator program, 3rd-6th grade students are provided an opportunity to become peer leaders.


Mentored by highly trained and experienced staff, they learn to plan, organize, and lead program activities, service-learning projects, and team-building activities.

My son, Caleb, and I came to Yuma, Arizona when he was 11 months old. We moved back home to Las Vegas to be with family during the COVID-19 pandemic, then returned to Yuma when he was in the middle of second grade.

When I looked online for daycare, I saw that Right At School offered a before and after school program at Caleb's new school. I was excited about that. I'm a single parent, I don't have family here who can help, so finding a program that was on-site at school was perfect for us.

In the beginning, Caleb struggled a little. The move was hard on him, and it was challenging being at a new school. I usually drop him off between 6:30 and 7:30 in the morning and then pick him up right before 6:00 pm. He was used to doing what he wanted at home and didn't want to join in the after school activities. Now he loves it!

One thing that helped a lot was that Caleb made friends at Right At School. At home, it's just him and me, so this gives him time to play with other kids and socialize. He likes all the fun things they do, and he likes the staff and enjoys being there.

I like the fact that I don't have to worry. I'm extremely busy every day, and there's a lot on my plate. Not having to worry about Caleb's safety and if he's okay makes everything so much better. I can focus at work and go about my day. That peace of mind is huge for me.

The Right At School staff are great. When I walk in to say hi, everyone is in such good spirits. They communicate with me all the time about everything, which is awesome. I know that if something were to happen, I would get a call or text right away. But I don't worry about that because I know Caleb is in good hands, and he's having fun. Other families I've talked to say the same thing. I've heard nothing but good things from everyone.

Yuma now feels like home in the sense that Caleb loves going to school here. He feels a sense of belonging, and it's because of Right At School. It's like a family atmosphere. He feels very secure there — and if he wasn't, he's the kind of kid who would let me know right away.

I would encourage parents, especially single parents, to utilize Right At School because this is the perfect program for you and your kids. It can be hard trying to figure out what to do with your child when you're at work. When Caleb was going to daycare, I'd have to go pick him up after school and drop him off somewhere else, and that took a lot of time away from work. With Right At School, your child stays at school, so you don't have to worry about that. You can stay at work and do your job.

Not having to worry about anything? I don't know how you can put a price on that. For us, it's been wonderful.


